Term 2

Learning Journey – Geography, DT(cooking and nutrition) and Science

This term the children will be answering the question, 'Why would you chose Lincolnshire to build your farm?'. In geography, we will using maps to locate cities and counties in the UK as well as a key focus on Lincolnshire. We will be creating a survey for our visit to Rand Farm Park to help us identify why Lincolnshire is a good place to farm using physical and human features. In DT, we will looking at foods that are produced and grown in Lincolnshire and will be sampling a selection of foods as well as focusing on what is a varied, balanced diet. At Rand Farm Park and within school, we will be using our skills of peeling, cutting and mashing to create and sausage and mash meal and evaluating them. In science, we will be investigating types of rocks and soils to understand why Lincolnshire is so good for farming.

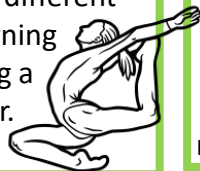
Has Christmas lost its true meaning?
