Learning Journey – History, Science & Art

This term the we will be answering the question, Where are the women in our history books?

This learning journey will incorporate our history, science and art learning. In history, we will be learning about different women who's actions have had an impact on modern day life. We will also be finding out about the Suffragette movement and the positive changes it brought about. In science, we will be learning all about solar power and how it works! Finally, to help us answer our learning question, we will be using our art skills to experiment with a range of different colours, textures and techniques to create our own artwork based on that of Frida Kahlo, a Mexican painter known for her many portraits and works inspired by the nature and artefacts of Mexico!

Is forgiveness always possible for Christians?

We will be learning about Christianity this term and start by discussing the word 'forgiveness' and what it means as well as why it might be difficult in some situations.

We will then look at the Easter story with a focus on the teaching of Jesus about forgiveness and the people that Jesus forgave.

Finally, we will consider what a Christian might learn about forgiveness from a Bible text.

PSHE

Our SCARF unit this half term is **Rights & Respect**. We will be learning about different people in the community that help to keep us safe, understanding who makes the rules in different places and why that have been put in place, and the rights that children along with how they are protected in this country.

Computing Data and Information

Every session will start with an E-safety mini session. Then we will use our knowledge of statistics to collect and analyse our own data from different areas in the classroom focusing on the brightness of the area, the noise level of the area, and its magnetic field level.

Modern Foreign Language - Spanish

This term our focus is learning the names of different types of animals. Our phonics practice will continue with our termly pronunciation sessions and we will continue to learn the grammar structures that help us put sentences together so that we can describe different animals.

Music

This term, the learning is focused around the song: Lean On Me. We will be learning how to find and repeat back the pulse, rhythm and pitch of the song as well as learning the song and having a go at singing it together!

We will also be listening to some other songs within the same genre and discussing any similarities and differences we notice.
