Top Tips

- The secret to success is practising little and often.
- Use time wisely. Practise on the way to school or during a journey.
 - Count whenever possible:
 Count stairs as you're climbing them.

 Count socks and shoes as you're putting them on.
 Cars going past.

When reading a book, count items in the pictures.

 Model counting as much as possible to your children so they hear the number names in the correct order.

Questions to Ask

How many forks have I got? Let's count them together.

How many cows are in the field in this picture?

How many fish fingers have you got for tea tonight?

Game Ideas

Use songs to help. For example:
 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive
 One, two buckle my shoe
