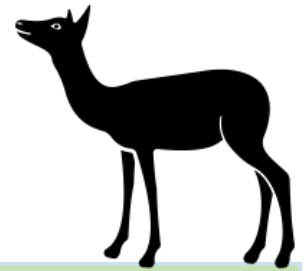




# Deer Class Curriculum Newsletter Term 2

### Computing systems & Networks
